Andew, we have been speaking to various charity organisations, drop-in centres, and Breakfast Clubs where communities of veterans from the UK armed forces, gather for breakfast mornings, chit chat over a cup of tea, sharing experiences during their service with the forces.

We would like the opportunity to simply speak with the members at one of your regular get togethers, regarding Noise Induced Hearing Loss (NIHL) from time spent in the forces, and provide all the necessary support to help all ex-service people get the compensation that they deserve.

Basically, following a landmark case a few years back, the Ministry of Defence (MoD) has accepted its duty of care to veterans and has dropped its primary argument regarding the timing of claims.

Anyone who served in the Armed Forces before 1987 was unable to claim compensation for hearing loss. This was because prior to this, the UK government had Crown Immunity from such claims.

The law was changed in 1987, allowing service personnel to claim compensation for injuries sustained during their service, including hearing loss.

The presenter will provide detailed information during the presentation and address any queries from the members at the time.
